Judge Beverly O'Connell – Serves as a U.S. District Court Judge for the Central District of California since 2013; worked at Morrison & Foerster; served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney assigned to the Joint Terrorism Task Force; served as a Superior Court Judge for Los Angeles County.

John Carson - Foley & Lardner Intellectual Property Practice; FBA-LA Board member; Former President of the L.A. County Bar Association; Chaired the Ninth Circuit's Advisory Board; Co-Authored the California Trade Secret Act; Ninth Judicial Circuit Historical Society Board Member; Former President of the L.A. County Bar Foundation; Chaired various ethics committees; Founder of the Trial Advocacy Project; Chaired District Court Attorney Discipline Committee.

PANELISTS

Judge James G. Carr - Served as a member of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court from 2002-08; U.S. District Judge for the Northern District of Ohio since 1994 and District Chief Judge from 2004-10; Graduated from Harvard Law School in 1966; Authored several books and articles, including a two volume treatise *The Law of Electronic Surveillance*.

Professor John Eastman - Chapman University School of Law; Former Dean of Chapman University School of Law; Director of the Center for Constitutional Jurisprudence; Chairman of the Federalist Society's Federalism & Separation of Powers practice group.

Steven Martinez - Stroz, Friedberg LLC; Former FBI Executive Assistant Director in charge of the FBI's Science and Technology Branch; Served as head of the FBI Los Angeles and Las Vegas field offices.

Cindy Cohn - Legal Director of Electronic Frontier Foundation; Served as the outside lead attorney in *Bernstein v. Dept of Justice*, a First Amendment challenge to the U.S. export restrictions on cryptography; Serves as counsel in *Jewel v. NSA* and *First Unitarian Church v. NSA* regarding warrantless surveillance of ordinary Americans; Served as coordinating counsel for over forty national class actions lawsuits against telecommunication carriers and the government regarding the warrantless surveillance.

Professor Seth Stodder - USC Law School; A counter terrorism expert and an authority in this area of law; Teaches a course titled "Counter-Terrorism, Civil Liberties and Privacy" at USC; Former Director of the Office of Policy for the Commissioner of Customs and Border Protection (CBP) of the Department of Homeland Security; Formerly an attorney with Gibson Dunn.

Andy Liepman - Former Principal Deputy Director of the National Counterterrorism Center; Spent more than 30 years in the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), including a tenure as Deputy Chief of the Office of Near East and South Asian Analysis, as Deputy Director of the Office of Weapons Intelligence, Arms Control and Nonproliferation, as Chief of the Office of Iraq Analysis, and as Deputy Chief of the CIA Counterterrorism Center; Currently a Senior Advisor Policy analyst at The RAND Corporation.

Shont Miller - Senior Attorney at the Legal & Corporate Affairs department of Microsoft Corporation; Product counsel for Microsoft Azure, a public cloud service that hosts enterprise customer applications and data in Microsoft data centers around the world; Formerly a litigator at Munger, Tolles & Olson in Los Angeles.
